This is an online training that shares how to facilitate experiential workshops using artistic approaches to support voice hearers and mental health service users.

Using creative methods such as art, literature, improvisation, and performance, the training promotes a person-centered approach that integrates the values of the Hearing Voices Movement and expressive art therapies.

There is an additional introduction module which specifically discusses the topic of 'Hearing Voices'. Encouraging critical thought around mental health distress, the human rights of those within psychiatric services, as well as alternative approaches to care and support for these challenges.


